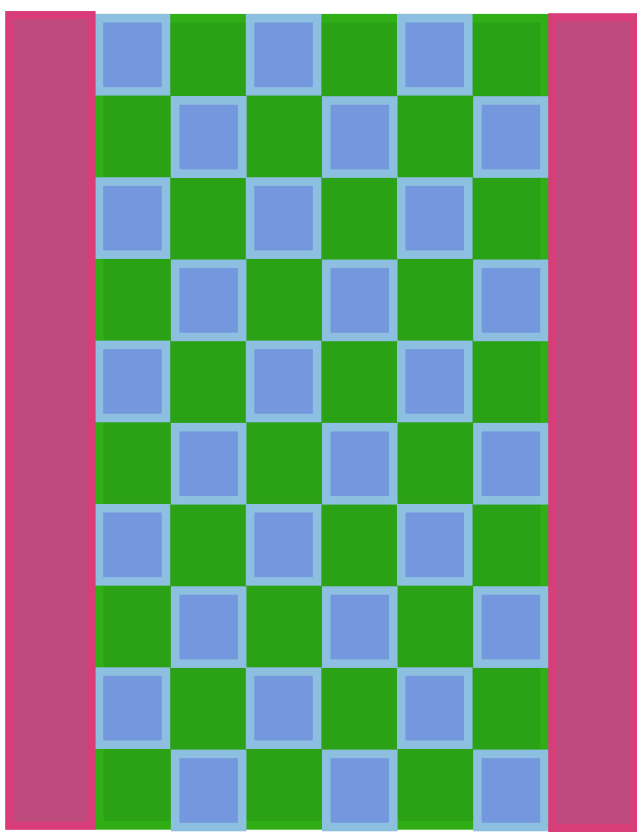


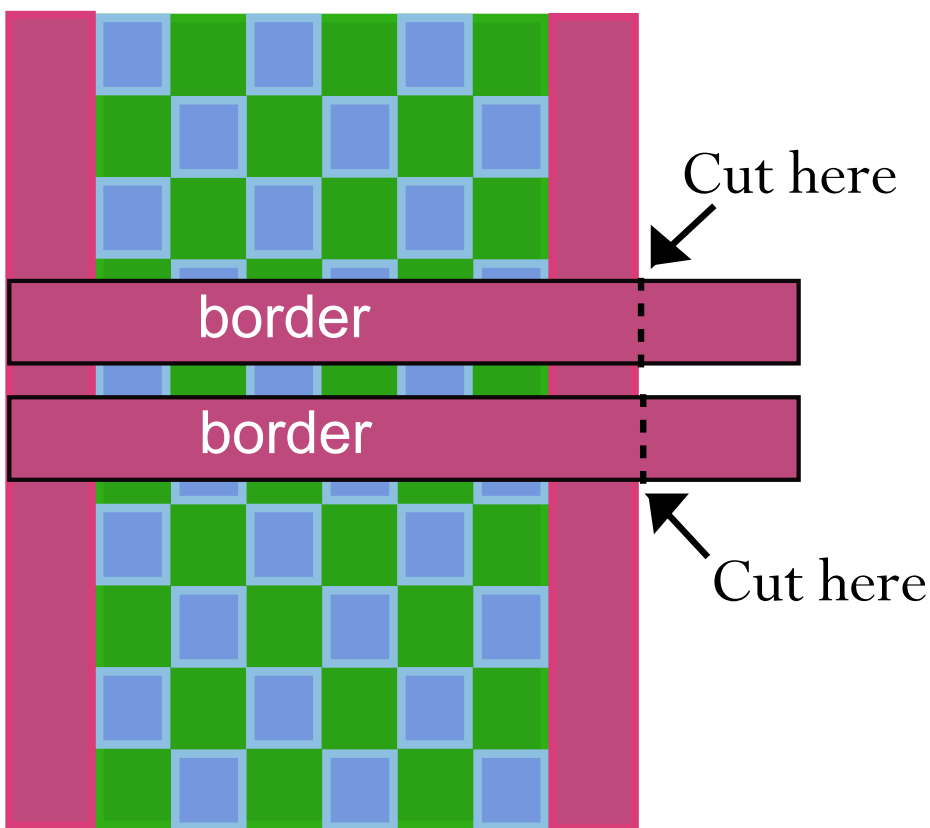
No tape measure necessary! Lay first two borders on top of your quilt top, in the center. Trim the borders even with the quilt top.

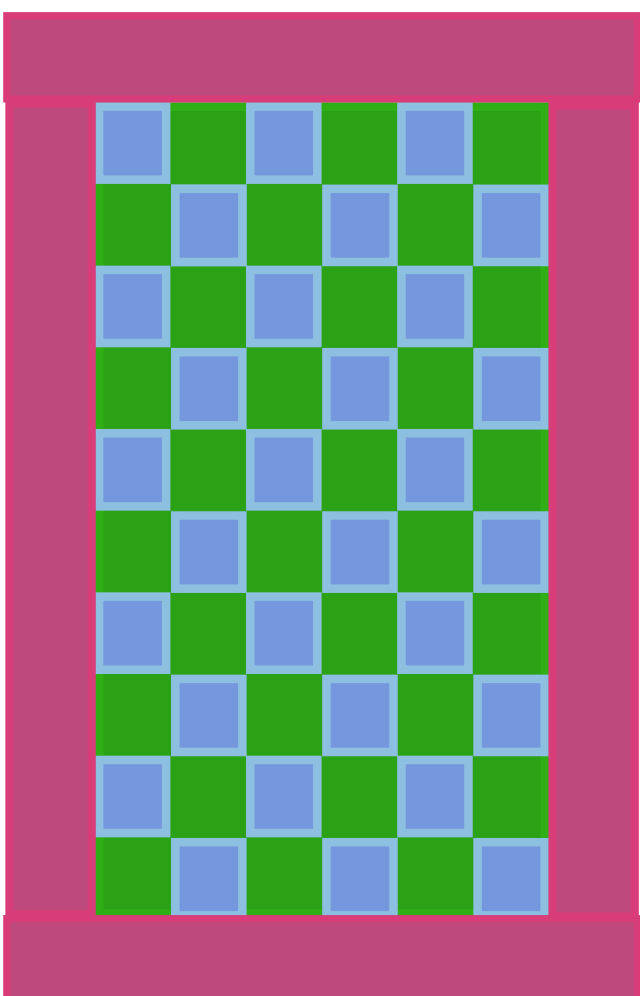
Here is the most important part. Pin your borders in place, and ease in any fullness. The quilt top edge may have stretched a little, and this can be worked in using plenty of pins along the seam to be sewed. Sew in place & iron seam allowance towards border.



Lay next two borders across quilt, and trim even with the edge of the quilt top (including previously attached borders).

Pin borders in place, again easing in any fullness. Sew, and iron seam towards border.

Now stand back & admire your quilt!
